

### **Reception Baseline Assessment**

If you have a child in the Reception class (F2) they will be participating in the reception baseline assessment (RBA) over the next few weeks. This is a statutory assessment that all Reception children take part in.

The RBA is a short, interactive and practical assessment of your child's early literacy, communication, language and mathematics skills, using materials that most children of your child's age will be familiar with. The outcome of the assessment is not reported unless requested, rather, it provides the starting point for a progress measure that will help parents understand how well schools support their pupils to progress between reception and year 6.
