Industries	Economic activity concerned with the manufacture of goods inside a factory.
Culture	Pattern of behaviour shared by a society, or group of people.

- Madrid is the capital city of Spain.
- Barcelona is the capital of Catalonia, an autonomous community of Spain.
- It is located on the coast of the Mediterranean Sea in north-eastern Spain.
- The city has a population of 1.6 million people.
- Barcelona has a hot summer Mediterranean climate.
- Around 12 million tourists visit Barcelona each year. They come to see famous sights such as architecture by Antoni Gaudí, which includes the Sagrada Família and Parc Güell, as well as Camp Nou which is home to FC Barcelona.
