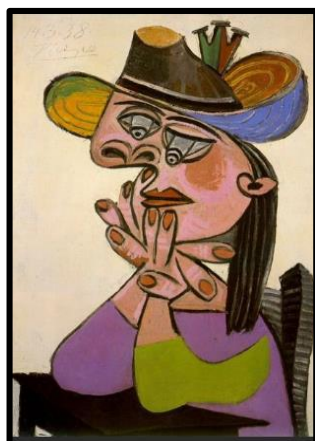


Pablo Picasso

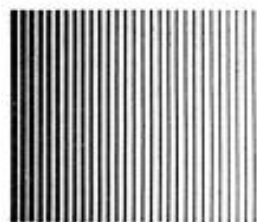
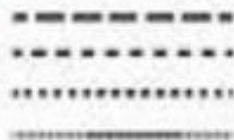
Lines

Pablo Picasso 1881-1973

Picasso was a Spanish artist. He is one of the most famous artists of the twentieth-century. He was brilliant at drawing. He liked to experiment and try out new ideas. Picasso helped us see the world in new ways.
