Spain

Spain is the 7th most populous country in Europe. The most populous city of Spain is Madrid and it has a population of around 5.2 million people. Spain are large worldwide exporters of clothes and footwear, food and drink, metals and chemicals. Spanish is spoken in many countries around the world, and so Spain have strong trade links with many other countries.

Spain is the largest country on the Iberian Peninsula, a part of south-western Europe. Spain is relatively flat compared to many countries. The longest river entirely in Spain is the Ebro. which is 930km long. Spain is very close to Africa! A strait of Gibraltar, Spain and Morocco are separated by only 9 miles!


